Report of the Bylaws Team
For the period ending April 12, 2019

The purpose of the Bylaws Team is to review the bylaws of OSMA, to make changes to the OSMA bylaws when changes are approved by the AAMA House of Delegates and mandated by AAMA bylaws. The Bylaws Team is also responsible for reviewing the bylaws of each Chapter of OSMA, on a rotating basis.

The Bylaws Team met several times for email discussions during the first quarter of 2019. All members participated in the discussions and decisions. A few housekeeping issues were addressed and corrections made. The consensus was to recommend no changes to the OSMA bylaws at this time.

The Bylaws Index and the Standing Rules have been updated to match the OSMA bylaws approved by the 2018 House of Delegates. The 2018-19 Bylaws were re-posted to the OSMA website and copies have been emailed to members of the OSMA Board.

Three of the four OSMA Chapters have submitted their updated Bylaws, reflecting the mandatory change the AAMA House of Delegates, approved in 2017 and the OSMA bylaws amendments approved by the 2018 OSMA House of Delegates. Those chapter bylaws were found to be in compliance with the AAMA and OSMA bylaws.
