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6 The purpose of the Bylaws Committee is to review the bylaws of OSMA, to make changes to the
7 OSMA bylaws when changes are approved by the AAMA House of Delegates and mandated by
8 AAMA bylaws. The Bylaws Committee is also responsible for reviewing the bylaws of each
9 Chapter of OSMA, on a rotating basis.
